

Employer Pricing Policy

Policy Statement

East Berkshire College values highly its work with employers. As part of this commitment we have developed a clear pricing strategy for the products and services that we offer to employers.

We ensure that our products are cost effective and provide value for money for our customers. We aim to advise employers about the full range of training options and other services we offer, as well as any associated funding subsidies they may be able to access. Policy Context

This policy applies to any individual or organisation that wishes to purchase products or services from East Berkshire College. The pricing strategy includes the full range of products we offer e.g. training offered via our prospectuses, scheduled and bespoke commercial training, consultancy services.

Pricing Strategy

There are a range of key factors that inform the pricing strategy and therefore the final prices we charge for products and services:

- Course delivery options e.g. individual enrolment on college courses, customised group training, work-based learning, distance learning
- Direct/indirect costs e.g. staffing, accommodation, management and administrative overheads
- Additional costs e.g. exam fees and material charges
- Group size - minimum/maximum numbers to ensure both viability and quality of learner experience
- Funding subsidies that may be available.

All fees will be agreed with you in advance and will be fixed.
